

Care of the Venus Fly-Trap

Venus Fly-Traps are the most remarkable plants in the world!

Care of the Venus Fly-Trap is very easy. These plants will take care of themselves as far as feeding goes. Did you know that a Trap only requires a few insects a year? Give them a lot of sunlight and water and you will be amazed at how they grow and function! As these plants mature, their traps will turn black. All you have to do is cut the black traps off and watch as new traps appear about six weeks later.

In the winter months you should let your Fly-Trap go dormant. Cut back all of the leaves, put the bulb (corm) in an unsealed zip-lock bag and place in the refrigerator to repot in Canadian peat. Place pot in a dish of water in a window with good sunlight. Enjoy the surprise of how fast your Fly-Trap grows!
